## "SOAP FOR LITTLE HANDS" DRIVE

Wayne area churches are once again holding a "Soap for Little Hands" (which now includes toothbrushes and toothpaste) drive to help children in the Rio Grande Valley of Texas.

In the past two years approximately 1,800 young folks have received soap, toothbrushes and toothpaste in their Christmas bags which are distributed by His Hands Ministry, Meadowlark Ministry and Christo Ray Ministries.

Because of the unrest in Mexico, these ministries have been told not to bring supplies across the border because the cartel's are watching them. This year all donations will be distributed to children on the US side of the boarder.

Buckets are available at the Wayne churches during the month of October. Please include only new/unused soap, toothbrushes and toothpaste. Thank you for supporting this ministry and helping to care for the needs of children in the lower Rio Grande Valley.

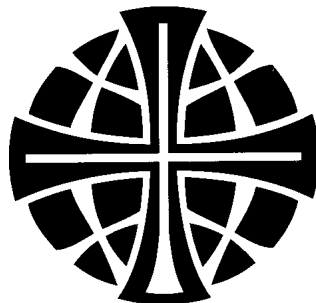
